

EXTENSION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
DATED: 01.04.2017 UP TO 31.05.2018
BETWEEN
SUVARNA AROGYA SURAKSHA TRUST (SAST)
AND

This Agreement made at Bangalore on this day of 01.04.2018 between Suvarna Arogya Suraksha Trust (SAST), a Trust incorporated under the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 and having its Registered Office at Bangalore Metropolitan Transport Corporation, TTMC "A" Block, 4th Floor, Shantinagar, KH Road, Bangalore - 560 027 hereinafter referred to as "TRUST", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof include its successors, Administrators and assignees of the ONE PART.

AND

_____ and having its establishment at _____ Hereinafter referred to as PROVIDER which expression shall unless to the context or meaning thereof and includes its successors, administrators and assignees of the OTHER PART.

WHEREAS, Trust is an independent nodal agency established by the Government of Karnataka providing health care to the identified beneficiaries through Network hospitals throughout the State for specified surgeries / therapies.

Suvarna Arogya Suraksha Trust desires to extend services under the said network of Providers and is willing to extend cashless medical care to the beneficiaries of Vajpayee Arogya Shree scheme.

Now this agreement witnesseth as under:

As per the GO order No. HFW 91 CGE 2017, dated 1.03.2018, point 74. for the period up to **30/05/2018** a resident needing tertiary healthcare treatment can avail the treatment from any Arogya Karnataka or Vajpayee Arogya Shree empanelled private hospitals without referral from PHI.

However, such patient will need to get enrolled either at the PHI, if the facility is available in the same district, or provide Aadhaar and PDS card number at the empanelled private hospital as a part of the pre- authorization activity.

Hence SAST has decided to extend the services that were hitherto provided under the Vajpayee Arogya Shree scheme for further period up to 31/05/2018 on Arogya Karnataka package rates for the specified treatments as per the above mentioned Government Order at in Annexure 8 and Annexure 9 tertiary emergency procedures of the said Government order. Claim settlement will be made accordingly.

The following modifications in the MOU dated 1/04/2017 have been agreed by both the parties and to enter into an agreement for extension of said MOU under Vajpayee Arogya Shree scheme as a Network Hospital.

1. The Hospitals have agreed to extend the services for Vajpayee Arogya Shree patients for the packages mentioned under tertiary and emergency(Annexure 8 and Annexure 9- tertiary Emergency procedures) in the GO no. HFW 91 CGE 2017 under Arogya Karnataka rates.

2. Hospitals have agreed to provide all benefits that were being provided under Vajpayee Arogya Shree as per VAS guidelines based on the MOU dated 1/04/2017 till 31.05.2018
3. SAST agrees to process bills within 45 days and payment will be transferred to hospitals once a month through RTGS / NEFT on package rates as mentioned in the GO No.HFW 91 CGE 2017, dated 1.03.2018
4. NABH incentives will continue as per the terms of MOU dated 1/04/2017 till May 31th 2018.
