**NOTIFICATION**

Subject: Mandatory display of Bed allocation Board in the Hospitals

\*\*\*\*\*

In the notification issued by Government of Karnataka on dated: 23.06.2020, it has been mandated to reserve 50% of the beds in private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients referred by public health authorities. The notification was issued under section 24 (f) & section (l) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

However, some patients are finding difficulty in getting beds even after the allocation is made by central allocation system of BBMP. This is causing a lot of hardship to patients. Therefore, it is made mandatory that all hospitals registered under K.P.M.E. in Karnataka State should display at the reception counter, a bed allocation display board which should display the following details:

- i) Name of the Hospital.
- ii) Total number of beds (as per of K.P.M.E. registration).
- iii) Total number of beds allocated for COVID-19 patients referred by BBMP (Minimum 50% of total hospital beds).



The above data must corroborate with the data of central bed allocation system of BBMP.

Display board should be arranged by 16.07.2020. Noncompliance to this order will attract punishment under relevant sections of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 and Indian Penal Code.
